

Rio Celeste: Sloth Sanctuary and Waterfall Hike

The story as told by the locals is that Rio Celeste got its stunning color when God dipped his brush in the river as he was painting the sky. Scientifically, the color appears when two separate clear water rivers meet and a certain type of mineral coated in silicon, oxygen and aluminum remains suspended in the river. The size, suspension and reflection of sunlight creates this vivid blue color in the water.

Rio Celeste National Park is located by the Tenorio Volcano. Our day starts with a 7 am pick up right at your door step.

Upon arriving to our destination, we begin our journey with a 1.5 hr hike where you can see the most amazing wildlife.

Then, we arrive to the river where we get to swim in the spectacular blue water. After the swim we head towards an animal sanctuary to visit the 2 and 3 toes sloth, butterfly, frogs, monkeys and many more animals. We end our adventure with a delicious authentic Costa Rican lunch.

La Leona Waterfall: Pristine Blue Water Waterfalls

La Leona Waterfall is located near a little town called Curubandé, at the base of the Rincon de la Vieja Volcano.

In this tour we will walk along the Rio Blanco. which feeds the La Leona waterfall. The high concentration of minerals in the volcanic water gives the water a striking turquoise color, unique to Guanacaste.

We will hike through canyons and caves, entering the water multiple times as it is the only possible route.

Your hard work will be rewarded when you arrive at the spectacular La Leona waterfall, hidden deep in the dense jungle. This is one of Costa Rica's best kept secrets.

After such amazing experience, we relax and enjoy a yummy typical Costa Rican lunch and then we head back home.

Vandara: Mega combo Volcano Tour

Vandara Hot Springs and Adventure is located on the outskirts of the Rincon de la Vieja Volcano.

We begin our adventure with the horseback riding. Enjoy the natural surroundings of the dry secondary forest and visit unique spots to enjoy incredible views of the San Roque hill, one of the great natural beauties of the area. Experience bird watching, tropical orchards path and organic gardens.

The Canopy awaits for us! Combining 8 cables and 9 platforms. Cable distances range from 100 to 400 meters long and have different heights, allowing you to experience a feeling of being one with nature. You'll get a view of the hot springs and the waterfall of property.

After zip lining, a thrilling 400 meter water slide will give you an adrenaline rush that finishes in a cold water pool.

Then, we head towards a traditional mill (powered by Oxen) with a firewood kitchen, a clay oven, piles, and more. The mill's mechanism turns the cane juice in "dulce" and liquor.

The thermal hot springs and mineral mud bath are our next stop. Relax and enjoy in two thermal water pools and the healing properties of the mud bath, this therapy with volcanic mud is ideal for those who wish to purify their skin while relaxing next to the magnificent waterfall.

Last, but not least, a garden to table traditional lunch will be served to top the day off.

Cañon de la Vieja Adventure and Llanos de Cortes Waterfall

Our tour begins at the beautiful Llanos del Cortes waterfall where you'll get to swim in its crystal-clear waters surrounded by an amazing tropical nature that will leave you totally astonished.

After such enjoyment, we head toward the Canon Lodge to start our adventure.

We start with the canopy tour, with a total of 8 cables and 16 platforms that travel from one end of the Colorado River canyon to the other, offering an impressive view of the nature below. Cables vary in length from 150m to 360m long and 75 m high.

Then, we hop on the horses and make our way to the river to begin the river tubing, not without first seeing the amazing flora and fauna this amazing area has to offer. Once at the river, get ready to have fun!! The exciting inner tube tour down the (class 2-3) rapids of the Rio Colorado with cool you off for sure! End your day at the natural geothermal hot springs and mud baths, heated from the underground volcanic activity in Rincon de la Vieja volcano.

The last stop is to enjoy a delicious traditional buffet lunch, with your choice of the best fresh Costa Rican fruits, juices, and local cuisine to enjoy.

Our tour begins with a 2-hour boat ride where you'll see iguanas, crocodiles, white face monkeys, howler monkeys, herons and many, many birds.

Guanacaste best Coffee Tour and Cooking Class

Our fruits, selected by expert hands, our beans, dried under the sun of Costa Rica guarantee a coffee with powerful aromas, roasted in a craft way for an exceptional coffee.

The degree to which coffee beans are roasted is one of the most important factors that determine the taste of the coffee in the cup. Before roasting, green coffee beans are soft, with a fresh “grassy” smell and little or no taste. The coffee roasting process transforms these raw beans into the distinctively aromatic, flavorful, crunchy beans that we recognize as coffee.

Other factors of course enter into the complex equation that determines your coffee’s taste. Two coffee varieties, from different countries of origin or grown in different environments, are likely to taste quite different even when roasted to the same level (especially at light to medium roast levels). The age of the coffee, the processing method, the grind, and the brewing method will also affect the taste. But the roast level provides a baseline, a rough guide to the taste you can expect.
